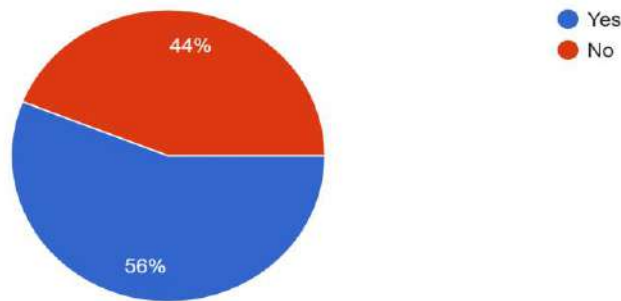

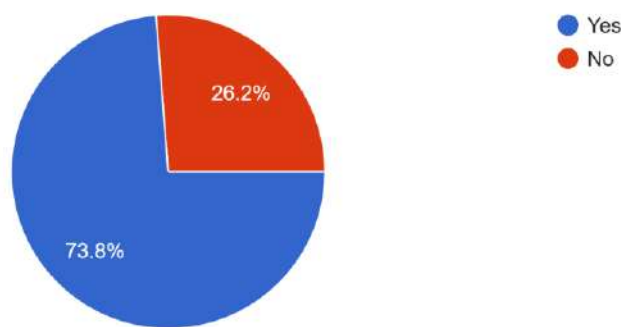
Are you a member of SSM alumni?

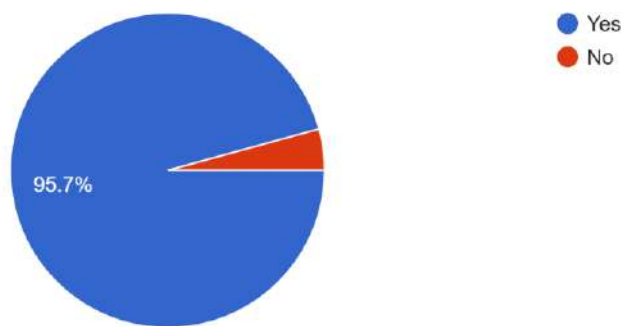

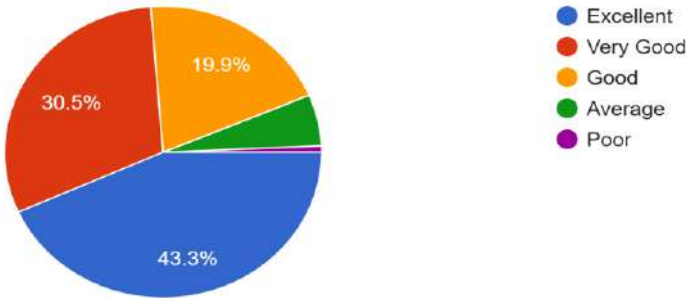

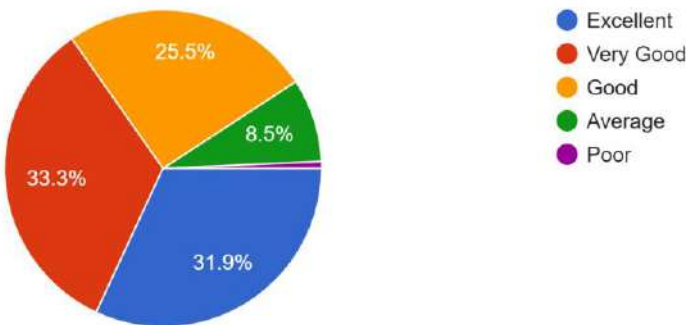
1. Teacher-student relationship when you studied in this college

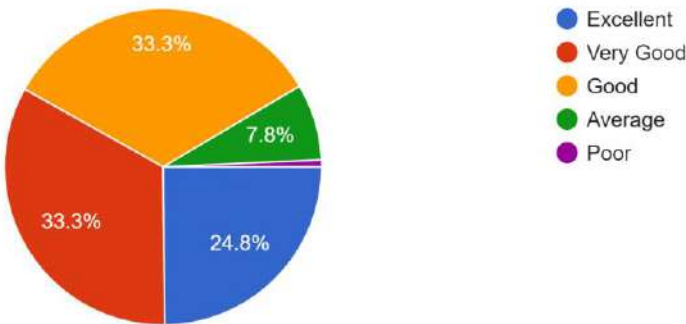

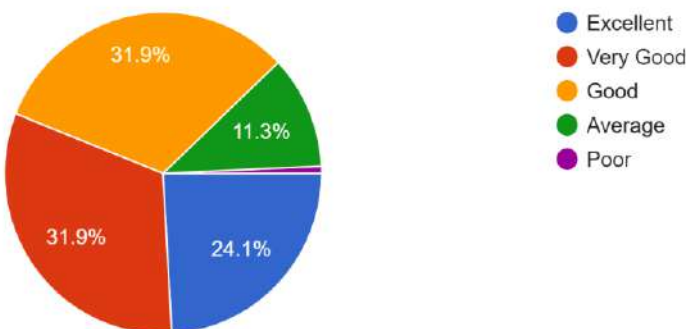

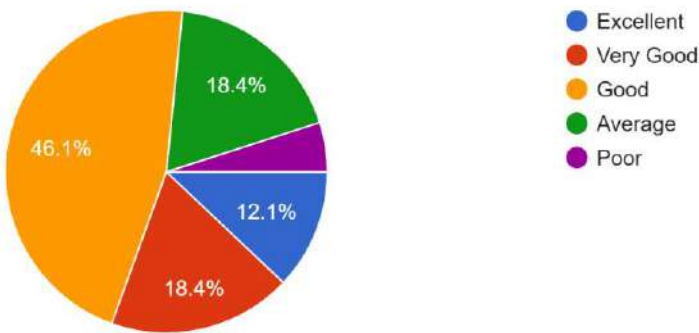

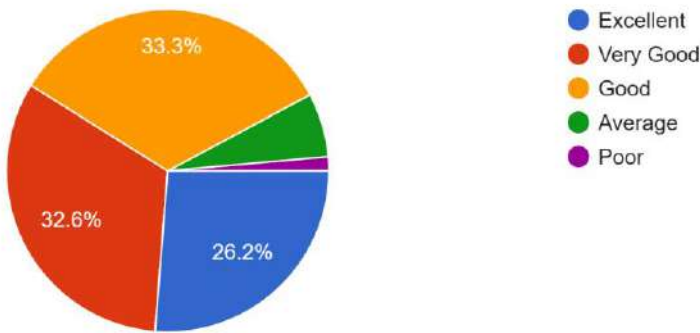

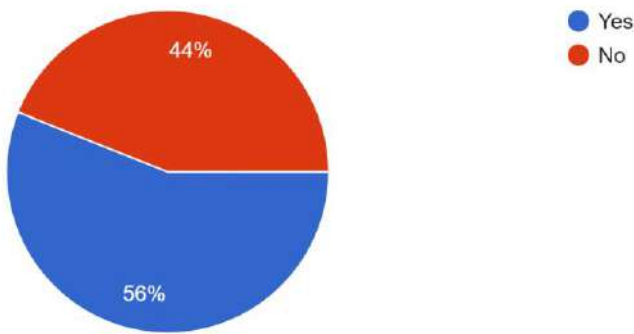
6. Development activities organized by the college for your overall development

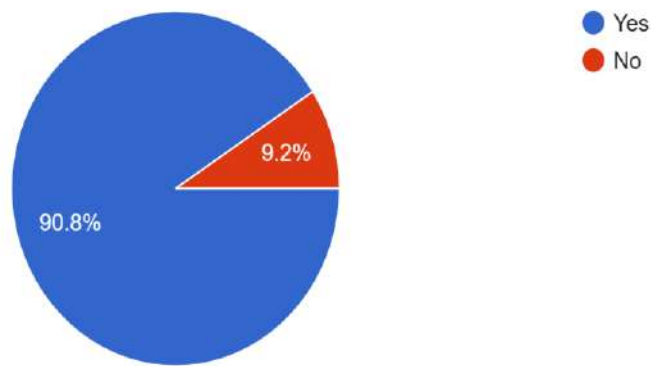

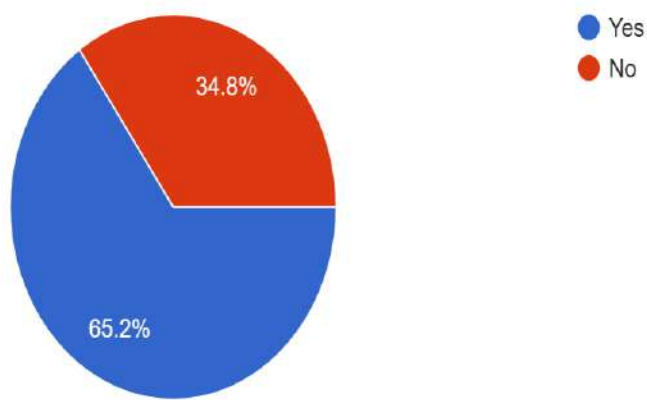
9. Do you feel that adequate knowledge was gained during your course of study?

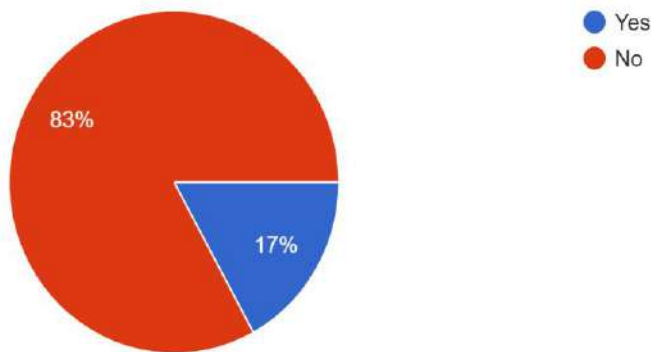
10. Is the knowledge gained in SSM relevant to your present job?
